Camp Howze MVPA is a 501 (C) 3 Non-Profit organization that is based in North Texas. A membership base that is in Texas and Oklahoma supports the Events, Educational and Veteran Services Programs. Camp Howze MVPA has been in existence since 2012 and filed for Non-profit in 2017.

Camp Howze MVPA's Educational Program known as "History Alive" or "History Alive Weekend" allows the membership to use the equipment and vehicles to educate the youth and the public on the Greatest Generation and their life. Our membership has amassed a large collection not only of vintage military vehicles, but artifacts, weapons, equipment and uniforms.

Our program includes learning stations of displays and interactive sessions on many different topics and types of vintage items. Not only have we hosted large events to the public, but we have taken our program to various schools, museums, and public events. We average about 20,000 persons per year that get exposed to our program.

During the Covid years we provided ZOOM interactions with school systems during their WWII lesson plans and aided the teacher in covering relevant topics to enhance learning.
